Rabia Basria Hostel (Named after the famous 8th century sufi saint Rabia-Al-Adawiyya from Basra) is a resident hostel for full-time postgraduate female students of the University of Kashmir. It is located in the main campus of the University. The Hostel was established in the year **2006**, which provides a comfortable, friendly and homely environment to the boarders. The Provost is the administrative head of the hostel. For internal administration and day-to-day discipline, the warden assists the Provost.

The hostel is a concrete 03 storey building having lush green lawns in and around. There are 39 rooms 36 rooms with four bed capacity and 03 rooms with eight bedded capacities. The common room attached to it provides moments of leisure. A spacious dining hall is used to serve breakfast, lunch, tea and dinner. Enough care is taken to provide the boarders hygienic, nutritious and quality food. For supervision of Mess facilities a committee has been constituted which includes a Mess secretary (student member), Mess manager (representing Hostel administration) and some students. The participation of the students in the committee maintains transparency of the mess affairs of the hostel. Allama Iqbal Library is at a walking distance. You may even access the book world via Wi-Fi while sitting in your hostel rooms. The hostel is also equipped with Genset for un-interrupted power supply.
